<p>STEP 1 On-line registration</p> <p>1st intake June 21 – July 11</p> <p>2nd intake August 2 – August 29</p>	<p>Create your individual registration account:</p> <p>Click here: https://irk.uw.edu.pl/en-gb/</p> <p>Choose <i>Foundation Year online course 2021</i>.</p> <p>Create an account by filling in the initial form.</p> <p>Log into your account and follow the next steps of registration:</p> <p>Click the <i>my account</i> button in the upper right corner.</p> <p>Go to <i>Enrollment applications</i> in order to choose either <i>Foundation Year-bachelor-level</i> or <i>Foundation Year-master-level</i>.</p> <p>Upload all necessary documents.</p>
<p>STEP 2 Checking language skills</p>	<p>Candidates with all required documents have their language skills checked.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidates who do not have English language certificate (B1 level or higher) take the online placement test. Those who pass are invited to the oral interview via UW Kampus Platform (https://kampus.come.uw.edu.pl). • Candidates who do have English language certificate (B1 level or higher) do <i>not</i> take the placement test. They are directly invited to the oral interview.
<p>STEP 3 Qualification procedure at the chosen faculties</p>	<p>The documents are assessed by the Admissions Committee of the Faculty conducting programs chosen by the Candidates.</p>
<p>STEP 4 Qualification for the program</p> <p>1st intake – no later than August 3 2nd intake – no later than September 20</p>	<p>All candidates who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • have submitted all necessary documents in the system • have fulfilled the language requirements • have been positively assessed by the chosen Faculty <p>obtain an e-mail with the conditions of acceptance and the bank account number to pay the course fee. The payment must be done within 5 working days after receiving the e-mail.</p>
<p>STEP 5 Acceptance Letter</p>	<p>After the payment is made, participants admitted for the Foundation Year receive their acceptance letter issued by the UW Vice-Rector for Student Affairs and Quality of Teaching.</p>
