



# ACCOMMODATION

The University of Warsaw offers 2 500 places in six dormitories situated in various parts of the city. Each dorm has a quiet study lounge, a TV room, a computer room and laundry facilities. Monthly rent ranges from EUR 87 to 152 (PLN 400-700) per person, depending on the type of room.

UW dormitories are conveniently located in Warsaw with an easy access to the city centre thanks to various transportation options. Visit [welcome.uw.edu.pl](https://welcome.uw.edu.pl) to learn more.

## How to apply?

### DEGREE PROGRAMME STUDENTS

If you are an international student coming to study on a BA or MA degree programme at UW, you can apply for a room via USOSweb. Make sure you check the deadline for applying as applications for dormitories are organised in several rounds.

### SHORT-TERM STUDENTS

Students who come to UW within various grant or exchange programmes are assigned accommodation from the pool of places available in dormitories prior to their arrival. You can obtain all the necessary information about on-campus accommodation from the International Relations Office.

Also, you can stay at one of the dormitories if you are participating in a faculty conference or have no connection to UW (e.g. during summer months some rooms are available to tourists).

# ACCOMMODATION

## Off-campus accommodation

If it happens that you don't secure a place in one of the UW dormitories, you can look for a room or an apartment on one of on-line classified websites or check out Facebook accommodation pages (eg. [The University of Warsaw Students' Union](#), [The University of Warsaw Students' Union UW accommodation](#), and [ESN Accommodation in Warsaw](#)).

Once you find a room or a flat, remember to sign a contract with the landlord. It is also a good idea to ask a Polish speaker to help you.

If you need a place in Warsaw for the first couple of days, you can look at options available on one of the hospitality services or in numerous youth hostels.
