



Regulations of the 'Draw out your gremlin" Workshop at the University of Warsaw 2022

I. BENEFICIARIES

§ 1

The workshop is dedicated to international students, especially:

- 2nd and 3rd year students of first cycle (Bachelor's degree),
- 4th and 5th year students of uniform Master studies,
- students of second cycle (Master's degree).

II. DURATION AND STRUCTURE

§ 2

The 'Draw out your gremlin' Workshop is a one-day long stationary event that will take place on March 25, 2022.

It includes 8 hours of workshops covering the following topics:

- 1. Presentation of most common patterns of self-sabotage: creating a 'storage of limiting beliefs' ignoring the positive and focusing on negative allowing fear to take over and guide one's thoughts and actions focusing on the past comparing with others settling for less to be "on the safe side" mastering procrastination;
- 2. Exercises and tools to find one's self-sabotage patterns;
- 3. Strategies to overcome self-sabotage and judgment reframing your weakness, creating one's own strategy and new thinking habits, boosting one's strengths;
- 4. Exercise: Learning "force-field analysis" and "ants model" to deal with your self-sabotage and inner critic;
- 5. Staying accountable to yourself and some more tips and tricks.

ADMISSIONS

- 6. Admissions will be held online through the Google Forms and will be available for each student meeting the criteria.
- 7. Information about the course will be published on UW websites, Facebook group "Welcome at University of Warsaw" and delivered to potential candidates via e-mail.









- 8. Acceptance to the course will be determined by order of applications and justification for participation.
- 9. Candidates who will not manage to sign up for the course on time will be put on the reserve list.

A participant who resigns from the course later than 3 days before the commencement of the course, will not be allowed to take part in any other activity organized by the Welcome Point UW during the academic year 2021/2022.

III. PAYMENT

Participation in the 'Draw out your gremlin' Workshop is free of charge. The cost of the course will be covered by the University of Warsaw. The workshop is organised within the Integrated Development Programme at the University of Warsaw and funded by European Social Fund.
