LEGALISATION OF STAY



EU/EEA citizens

You can enter Poland and stay within its territory for up to 3 months on the basis of a valid travel document (passport) or other valid document confirming your identity and citizenship.

non-EU/EEA citizens

You can enter Poland with a valid travel document (such as a passport) and – if required – a visa. A list of visa-free countries is available on the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website:

For stays exceeding three months, you have to register your residence.

A Schengen Visa (marked with a 'C' symbol) is issued when the planned stay on the territory of the Schengen area does not exceed 90 days within each 180-day period.

A national visa (marked with a 'D' symbol) – entitles the bearer to entry and continuous stay on the territory of Poland or to several consecutive stays which cumulatively last longer than 90 days – the period of validity of a national visa cannot exceed 1 year.

WHAT DOCUMENTS NEED TO BE SUBMITTED?

- 1 copy of an application for registering your residence
- 4 photographs (35mm x45mm, taken not earlier than 6 months before the date of application)
- a statement of the date of the last border crossing
- a travel document (passport) or other document confirming identity and citizenship
- a confirmation, issued by the Faculty office, of acceptance or continuation of your studies/ certificate of participation in a training course
- a document confirming health insurance which covers the cost of treatment or a document confirming the right to receive health care in Poland
- a proof or written declaration of having sufficient funds for living and studying in Poland

- 2 copies of the application for a temporary residence permit
- 4 recent colour photographs
- a valid travel document (passport, 2 photocopies)
- stamp duty PLN 340
- a confirmation, issued by the Faculty office, of acceptance or continuation of your studies/ certificate of participation in a training course
- transcript of records
- proof of payment of tuition fees or confirmation that you do not have to pay for studies (e.g. a scholarship certificate, a document from the faculty student office)
- a document confirming possession of health insurance which covers the cost of treatment in Poland
- proof of sufficient funds for living and studying in Poland and return travel to your home country
- documents confirming having a place to live in Poland (e.g. lease agreement) information about utilities expenses (such as electricity, water, waste disposal, heating, and sewage)

Foreign language documents should be submitted together with their translations into Polish prepared by a sworn translator.
