



## **Regulations of the ‘Campus Field Game’ at the University of Warsaw 2025/2026**

### **I. BENEFICIARIES**

#### **§ 1**

The Game is dedicated to international (non-Polish) students, full time and short-time, of the University of Warsaw:

- Students of Bachelor Studies (1<sup>st</sup> cycle studies)
- Students of Master Studies (2<sup>nd</sup> cycle and uniform Master Studies),
- Doctoral Students.

### **II. DURATION AND STRUCTURE**

#### **§ 2**

- 1 The ‘Campus Field Game’ is a single stationary event that will take place on October 14th, 2025, 11.30 am – 1.00 pm.

The ‘Campus Field Game’ is an interactive integration activity designed to help international students of the University of Warsaw become familiar with the University’s Main Campus and its cultural environment. Through teamwork and task-solving, participants will explore key locations, learn about the University’s history and community, and strengthen their sense of belonging. The event combines educational and recreational elements, encouraging collaboration, creativity, and intercultural exchange among participants.

### **III. ADMISSIONS**

#### **§ 3**

1. Admissions will be held online through the Google Forms and will be available for each student meeting the criteria.
2. Information about the Game will be published on UW websites and UW social media and delivered to potential candidates via e-mail.
